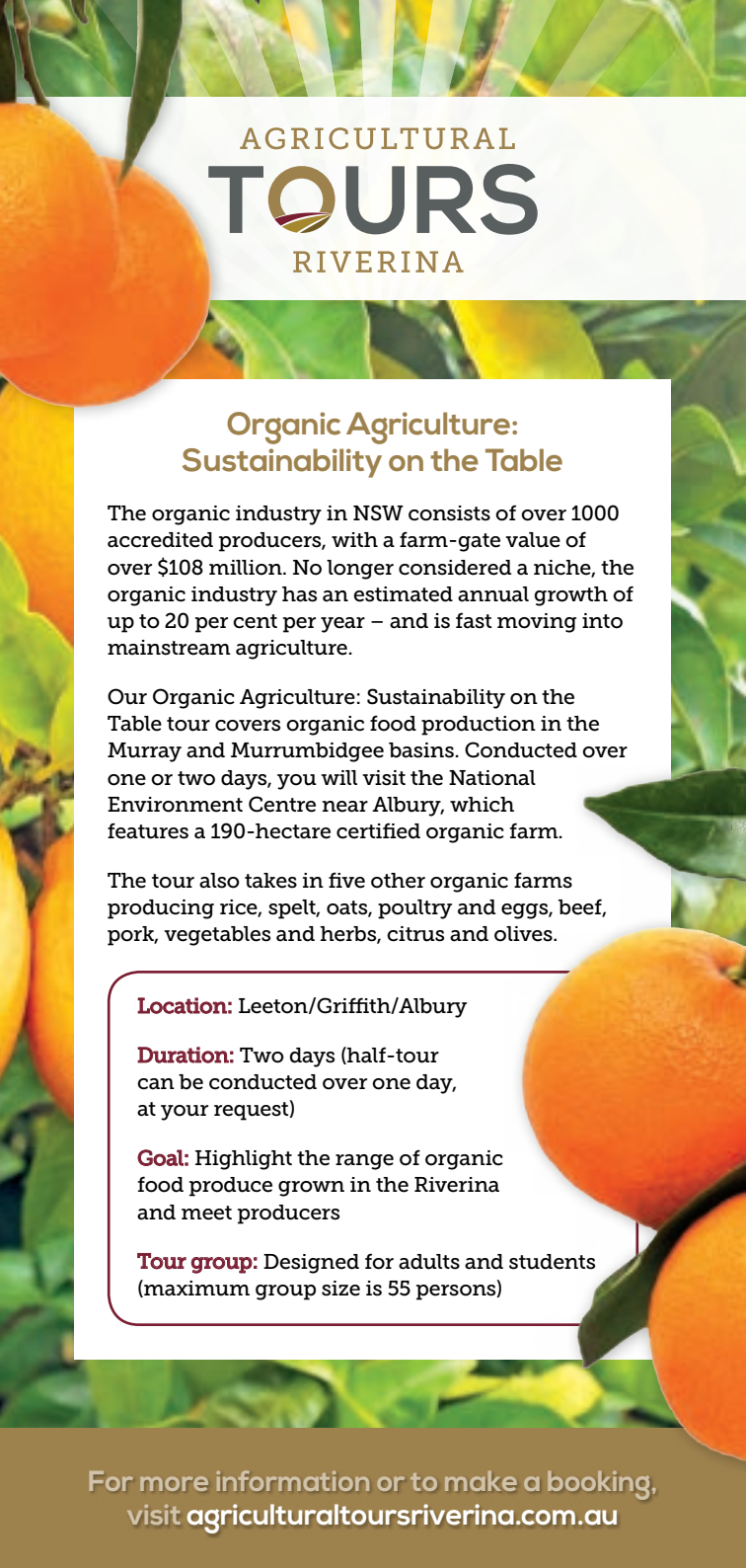

Organic Agriculture: Sustainability on the Table

The organic industry in NSW consists of over 1000 accredited producers, with a farm-gate value of over \$108 million. No longer considered a niche, the organic industry has an estimated annual growth of up to 20 per cent per year – and is fast moving into mainstream agriculture.

Our Organic Agriculture: Sustainability on the Table tour covers organic food production in the Murray and Murrumbidgee basins. Conducted over one or two days, you will visit the National Environment Centre near Albury, which features a 190-hectare certified organic farm.

The tour also takes in five other organic farms producing rice, spelt, oats, poultry and eggs, beef, pork, vegetables and herbs, citrus and olives.

Location: Leeton/Griffith/Albury

Duration: Two days (half-tour can be conducted over one day, at your request)

Goal: Highlight the range of organic food produce grown in the Riverina and meet producers

Tour group: Designed for adults and students (maximum group size is 55 persons)

The Farming in the Riverina: Food and Fibre tour takes in the region's key farming enterprises (seasonal) and processing plants.

Each day you visit four commercial farms or agricultural service businesses of your choice:

Cotton | rice | citrus | nuts | tree fruits
table or wine grapes | sunflowers | lucerne hay
seed suppliers | beef | wool | sheep | olives | milk
cereals | vegetables | horses | working dogs
water management | eggs, poultry
farm machinery | sheep and cattle auctions
farm engineering
