Water in the Riverina

Our Water in the Riverina tour highlights the multiple roles played by managed water in both preserving and changing natural and man-made ecosystems in the Murrumbidgee Irrigation Area. You will visit sites important to controlling water flow, and those using water for farming, product processing, municipal, ecosystem management and recreation purposes.

Farmers, water managers and ecologists will share their insights during the one-day tour.

Duration: Five to seven hours (your choice), including lunch and refreshment breaks

Goal: Demonstrate the productive uses of water in Australia's biggest and oldest irrigation scheme

Tour group: Designed for adults and senior students (maximum group size is 55 persons)

Rice Farming in the Riverina

Our one-day Rice Farming in the Riverina tour takes in the birthplace of Australia's rice industry, and highlights its role in the economy of Australia and the Riverina region of NSW. You will visit a commercial rice farm, historical sites and water management systems in operation.

Major droughts, the Murray Darling Basin Plan, radical changes to rural economies and communities, and successful negotiation of free-trade agreements with Asian trading partners heavily dependent on rice, have intensified public interest in this major rural industry.

Farmers, rice industry representatives, water management equipment sellers/designers and ecologists will share their insights during the tour.

Duration: Six hours, including lunch and refreshment breaks

Goal: Provide accurate information on the region's rice industry

Tour group: Designed for adults and students (maximum group size is 55 persons)
