Your guide will take you to a special location with uninterrupted views to watch the sunrise over this amazing monolith. Enjoy a picnic breakfast before you experience the highlights of Uluru. Your guide will walk you to Mutitjulu Waterhole where you will learn the creation stories of Liru (venomous snake) and Kuniya (woma python). You will drive around the base of Uluru before returning to the resort.

SEIT Uluru Trek (SUT)

As you start your sunrise trek around the full 12 kilometre base trail of Uluru you will embrace the culture, geology and environment that is the essence of this amazing monolith. Your guide will tell the cultural stories (Tjukurpa) of Liru (venomous snake) and Kuniya (woma python), as well as many other Aboriginal creation stories associated with this central Australian icon. Along the trail you will witness sunrise, visit waterholes and the rock art sites of the ancients and learn of Uluru's cultural significance to the Anangu (local Aboriginal) people.

Inclusions: SEIT professional guide, outback picnic breakfast, hot water flask with tea, coffee and bottled water all carried by guest in a pack

SEIT Uluru (SUL)

Come and join your SEIT guide in your small group tour vehicle to explore the most profound and culturally significant monolith in Australia. Embrace the culture, geology and environment that is Uluru. You will meander into Mutitjulu Waterhole, undertake the Mala Walk and visit rock art sites with your guide to learn of Uluru's significance to the Anangu (local Aboriginal) people. Adjourn to the Talinguru Nyakuntjaku viewing area where you will observe an uninterrupted sunset over Uluru with Kata Tjuta in the distance. Sip on chilled sparkling wine as the sun sets in the west.

SEIT Kata Tjuta (SKT)

Revel in the early morning serenity of a truly spiritual place as the sunrise colours change on Kata Tjuta. Enjoy a picnic breakfast overlooking this Central Australian icon. Learn about this diverse environment whilst walking between the mighty conglomerate rock walls into Walpa Gorge. Take time to listen to the wind (Walpa) far above and view the scale of the rock walls that surround you. The spirituality of this amazing location embraces everyone who ventures here.

SEIT Valley of the Winds (SVW)

Welcome to the world of Kata Tjuta and the Valley of the Winds. These spiritual domes offer a challenging (Grade 4) walk between the giant geological formations. Your guide will lead you on this 7.5km walk, (the entire circuit) through this sacred men's area where you will see a diverse range of flora and learn about the European history of this amazing region.

Please note: Seasonal walk only available between April 1 and October 31. High level of fitness required - rocky, uneven terrain with steep ascents and descents. Not suitable for children under 5 years of age.

SEIT Kata Tjuta Domes (SKD)

Walk through the windy Walpa Gorge where thirty-six giant domes (The Olgas) tower above. Covered by sea 500 million years ago, soft rock eroded away as Kata Tjuta remained. Kata Tjuta means 'many heads' in local Pitjantjatjara Aboriginal language, and is a sacred site to the male Anangu Aboriginal people. Your tour ends back at your hotel, leaving time to freshen up for any dinner experiences you may have planned.

Please note: During summer (December – March) the itinerary changes. Instead of walking through Walpa Gorge, stops are made at the Southern Dune Viewing Platform for panoramic views of Kata Tjuta and Uluru in the distance. A stop is then made at the Western lookout, where you'll travel closer to Kata Tjuta. Finally, a short drive is taken on the famous Great Central Road to the western boundary of the National Park.

SEIT Patji (SPA)

A true Aboriginal experience

Accompany the Traditional Uluru Family to their homelands called Patji and spend time learning about the oldest living culture in the world. A unique and exclusive touring experience, Patji is located just outside of Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park south of Uluru. Explore this extraordinary environment by 4WD with your Aboriginal guide, stopping along the journey to hear stories such as how Paddy Uluru fought for Aboriginal land rights to where Uluru is today. The Uluru family will share their personal story with you during this authentic cultural experience. Join them for afternoon tea under a remote shelter to hear how they survived in this desert environment before tourism started in the region. Continue on to a private sand dune to view the great expanse of the desert overlooking Uluru and Kata Tjuta enjoying sunset with drinks and light snacks.

Please note: Aboriginal hosts are traditional people with strong cultural obligations. When cultural events occur an Aboriginal host may not be available, and this is beyond the control of SEIT. If temperatures reach above 36°C, SEIT has the option of cancelling this tour due to excessive heat. Not suitable for children under 5 years of age.

While you enjoy a glass of sparkling wine, you will be captivated by the spectacular changing colours of sunset in the outback. Relish an outback dinner at Curtin Springs Station, before returning to Ayers Rock Resort.

DAINTREE DREAMING, QUEENSLAND

Traditional Aboriginal Fishing (SDDF)

When you arrive at the Kuku Yalanji traditional fishing grounds on Cooya Beach, head out into nature searching for fish and periwinkles. This unique experience is endorsed by Tourism Australia as part of their Discover Aboriginal Experiences program, perfect for those who want an authentic afternoon, connecting with culture amongst nature. You'll be hands-on, gathering bush tucker deep within mangrove trees, where roots intertwine beneath your bare feet as you dig down to find clams. Your teacher shares how the community, the Kubirri Warra people, live harmoniously, taking only what they need from the land. Their foraging techniques have been passed down from generation to generation, collecting food for their family or for a cook-up, which you're invited to.

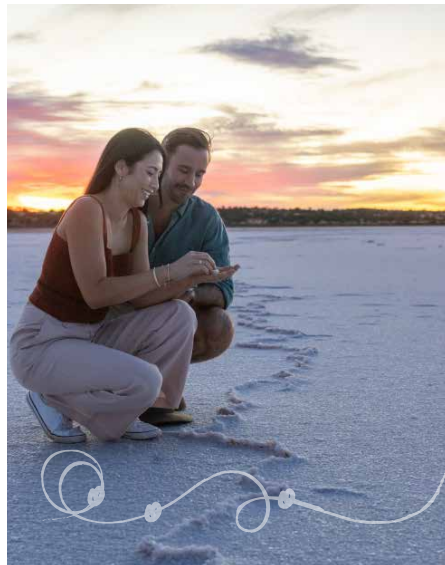

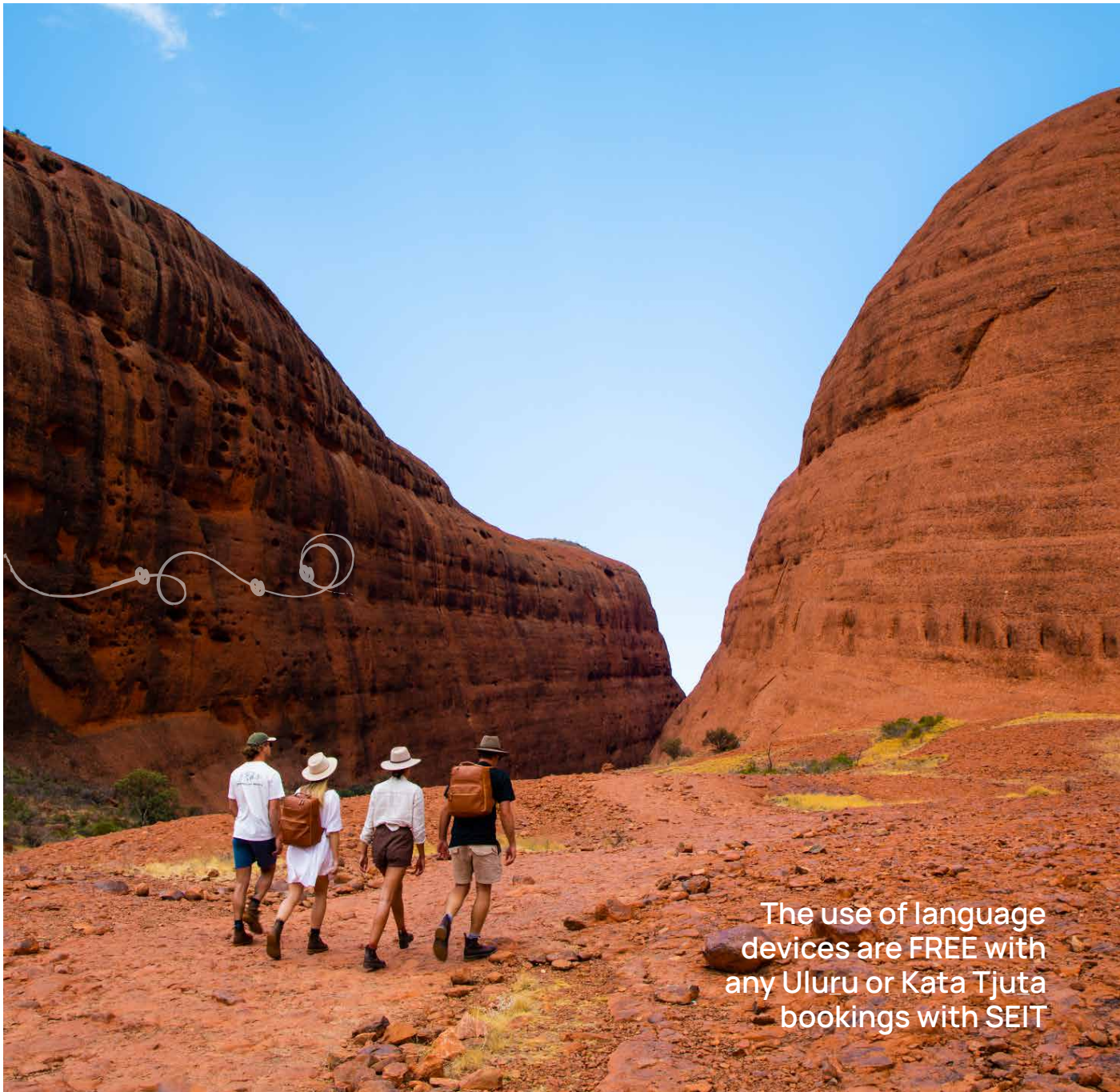
