Kakadu Day Tour

Duration: 13.5 Hours

Travel through pristine wetland regions into Kakadu National Park. Visit the Warradjan Cultural Centre to view the informative displays depicting the traditions of the Aboriginal people in Kakadu.

Join your local guide on a cruise on Yellow Water Billabong. Search for saltwater crocodiles and the colourful range of birdlife for which this region is renowned. After lunch, stop at Burrungkuy (Nourlangie), where your Driver Guide will lead you on a walk to view the ancient rock art galleries.

Tiwi Island Aboriginal Cultural Tour

Duration: 10.5 Hours

Take the 2½ hour cruise to Bathurst Island. You'll be met by your local guide for a journey through the progressive, modern day Aboriginal community of Wurrumiyanga.

Visit the Museum and Early Mission Precinct. Spend time with some Tiwi ladies, while they work on their weaving and painting. They will demonstrate their totem dances and perform a smoking ceremony to bless the visitors. You'll sample billy tea and damper before lunch. Visit the Arts & Crafts Centres, where you can purchase art and crafts at is-land prices. Transfer to your ferry departing the island at 3.15pm for Darwin.

Darwin City Sights Tour

Jumping Crocs Nature Adventure

Duration: 5 Hours

Travel out to the Adelaide River and cruise the river and thrill as these awe-some creatures launch themselves out of the water. The cruise will enable you to see these prehistoric creatures at close range. Afterwards continue to Fogg Dam Nature Reserve to view a wetland eco-system up close. It's also a good opportunity to spot birds and other wild-life.

Nitmiluk (Katherine) Day Tour

Duration: 14 Hours

Stop at the Adelaide River War Cemetery. Continue to Edith Falls for a swim in the waterhole beneath the falls (conditions permitting). Cruise through Nitmiluk (Katherine) Gorge with a chance to see freshwater croco-diles. The cruise of the first two gorges takes us past sheer rock walls and requires a short walk to reach the second gorge. Return to Darwin through Katherine, and via Pine Creek.

2 Day Kakadu & East Alligator River

Duration: 2 Days

Day 1

Depart Darwin and travel into Kakadu National Park. Visit the Warradjan Cultural Centre, then join your local guide on an award-winning cruise to experience the dramatic scenery of the Yellow Water Billabong. Keep an eye out for saltwater crocodiles, a diverse array of smaller wildlife, and the colourful range of birdlife for which this region is renowned.

Overnight in Kakadu (Cooinda or Jabiru) not included.

Day 2

This morning, explore the World Heritage area of Ubirr, where you'll explore extensive Aboriginal rock art galleries believed to be 20,000 years old. Then take the Guluyambi Cultural Cruise* along the East Alligator River, where an Aboriginal guide will provide insights into their culture, including local mythology, the river's abundant food chain, as well as bush survival skills.

Stop for lunch at the Mercure Croc Hotel before returning to Darwin.
