Bruny Island is one of the most iconic tourist regions of Southern Tasmania, with magical scenery, tasty local produce and a fascinating history. On our signature day tour, guests will be treated to the best of Bruny Island with a fully inclusive experience.

Departing from Hobart, this full-day tour is one of the best ways to experience Bruny Island. Throughout the day, guests have the opportunity to experience the icons and hidden gems of Bruny, starting the day with a walk to The Neck Lookout and Wildlife Reserve for stunning 360-degree views of Bruny Island and beyond.

Our picnic-style morning tea, consisting of oysters, Bruny Island Cheese and freshly baked bread, is prepared by the tour guide on one of the white sand beaches of Bruny Island, away from the crowds. After morning tea, the tour continues to explore the rest of the island.

As we drive south, guests may have a chance to see the elusive white wallabies in the wild, as well as take a short walk through a beautiful rainforest before continuing to South Bruny National Park.

South Bruny National Park is home to Cape Bruny Lighthouse, the only Lighthouse in Southern Tasmania open for tours. As part of our signature day tour, guests will be treated to an exclusive private lighthouse tour; we are proud to be the only operator with access to Cape Bruny Lighthouse in Tasmania. On this tour, guests will learn about the local shipwrecks, what it was like to be a Lighthouse Keeper and how it was built by convicts.

Hotel Bruny is the main hotel on the island and has a fantastic restaurant overlooking Sunset Bay. Here, guests can choose a one-course meal to enjoy, the menu is seasonal and has a focus on using produce local to Bruny Island. Throughout the afternoon, guests will also be treated to a tasting at Bruny Island Honey and a private tasting at Bruny Island Chocolate Co.

The tour aims to return to Hobart by 5.30 pm, with selected hotel drop-off available. We do recommend guests bring a water bottle and ensure they are wearing comfortable and warm clothing.

Departing from Hobart, we take the scenic drive to Kettering to catch the vehicle ferry over to Bruny Island. Once on Bruny, our tour guide will stop briefly at Get Shucked Oysters and Bruny Island Cheese Co. to collect morning tea, which will be enjoyed on one of the white sand beaches of Bruny. The journey continues to The Neck Lookout for 360-degree views of Bruny Island and 'mainland' Tasmania.

As we drive south, guests will have the opportunity to see white wallabies in the wild, as well as take a short walk through a stunning rainforest, one of four different forest types found on Bruny Island.

South Bruny National Park is home to the heritage-listed Cape Bruny Lighthouse, the only Lighthouse in Southern Tasmania open for tours. As part of this private day tour, guests will be treated to an exclusive lighthouse tour. On this tour, guests will learn about the local shipwrecks, what it was like to be a Lighthouse Keeper and how the convicts built this incredible lighthouse almost 200 years ago.

Bruny Island Premium Wines is the only vineyard on Bruny Island and has a fantastic restaurant overlooking the bushland and the vines. Here, guests can choose between one or two meal to enjoy, the menu is seasonal and has a focus on using Bruny Island produce. Guests will also be treated to a wine tasting of the award-winning wines produced here at Bruny Island Premium wines.

Throughout the afternoon, guests can enjoy honey tastings at Bruny Island Honey and a private chocolate and fudge tasting at Bruny Island Chocolate Co. This experience encapsulates the very best of Bruny Island with more tastings and unique experiences than our signature day tour.

Distillery Tours Tasmania

This is the ultimate experience for anyone who loves fine spirits and wants to learn about the art of distilling. Departing from Hobart at 9.30 am, this day tour includes all tastings and lunch.

On this tour, guests will taste some of the world's finest whiskies, gins, vodkas, and liqueurs. The tour also caters to those experienced and knowledgeable about the world of spirits. Visiting three of Southern Tasmania's top distilleries, guests will go behind the scenes at a distillery not open to the public, enjoy tastings of several spirits, and have a tasty lunch in a distillery loft.

Throughout the day, guests will learn more about the fine art of distillation and sample unreleased spirits. Morning tea, consisting of a cheese platter, is also included on the tour.

Spring Bay Distillery

The owners, Susanne and Cam, are delighted to tell their story before guests enjoy spirit tastings and distillery experience. Spring Bay has a newly built Solera where guests can bottle their very own 200ml bottle of cask-strength Whisky*.

Hobart Whisky - Devil's Distillery

Closed to the public, this is a true behind-the-scenes experience where guests will meet the distillers in person. They talk through the repurposed old Egg Factory and how they make the "Water of Life" like no other. Using a Whisky Thief, guests can be the first to draw samples from barrels that are upcoming releases, never sampled by the public.

Killara Distillery

One of the newest distilleries on the scene and its owner, Kristy Lark, is of local distiller heritage. Here, guests will meet and chat with Kristy and her distiller team about the beautiful distillery they have lovingly created. Tastings at Killara include their famous Lavender Gin, whisky and liqueurs.

Tasman Safaris

The Tasman Peninsula in Tasmania is renowned for its diverse landscapes and attractions. With its stunning coastlines, sea caves, rich convict history, and delicious food produce, it is a must-visit destination. Departing Hobart at approximately 7 am, this tour explores the icons and hidden gems of the Peninsula.

The morning will be spent exploring some of the lookouts of the Tasman Peninsula, including Eaglehawk Neck Lookout and The Tasman Blowhole. After ample photo opportunities, the next stop of the day is the UNESCO World Heritage Listed Port Arthur Historic Site, where guests can enjoy a short harbour cruise and audio guide of the history of the site.

The next stop brings us to Tasmanian Chocolate Company, where guests can witness skilled chocolate makers in action while sampling their delectable treats. After some tasty chocolate, the tour stops by the Tasman Honey Farm, with exclusive group access granted inside their factory walls, guests will have the opportunity to learn about the Tasmanian honey industry and its production processes.

Bangor Vineyard is the lunch location on this tour; guests can choose a 1-course meal from their seasonal menu. Bangor's restaurant is a perfect example of making the most of local produce, with many of its food supplies coming from the Tasman Peninsula itself.

Dunalley Bay Distillery is the last stop on this tour, with views looking over towards Mt Wellington, this distillery makes the perfect location to visit before heading back to Hobart. Guests will be treated to oysters from a nearby oyster farm and Dunalley Bay Distillery's tasty spirits whilst enjoying the stunning scenery of Norfolk Bay & the Tasman Peninsula.

Coal River Valley Safaris

Departing from Hobart, the Coal River Valley Safaris offers a blend of history, stunning scenery, local produce and, of course, award-winning wines from one of the best wine regions in Tasmania.

The day starts with the tour guide sharing the history of The Tasman Bridge as they drive alongside the stunning Derwent River and over the Tasman Bridge. The history continues as we take the short drive to Kangaroo Bluff Battery Historic Site, originally built in the late 1800s, to prevent enemy vessels from posing a threat to Hobart. Over 150 years later, the Battery now makes for a perfect viewing area for magical views of Hobart, Mt Wellington and beyond.

The journey continues as we make our way to the Coal River Valley, where the first stop is Wicked Cheese for morning tea. Guests will soon see why Wicked Cheese has won over 50 awards in the past decade for their locally produced cheese. While in the region, we will also visit Nocton Vineyard, Every Man & His Dog, Frogmore Creek Restaurant and the historic town of Richmond.

The lunch location for today is Frogmore Creek Winery, where guests will be treated to a 2-course lunch & wine tasting. The dishes created by the chefs here pay tribute to the beautiful produce of Tasmania and the diversity of kitchens around the world.

Each of the businesses visited on this tour is locally owned and operated, all sharing the same passion for the beautiful region of Southern Tasmania where they work and live. The Coal River Valley tour showcases the smaller businesses with their outstanding and award-winning products. We finish the day with time in Richmond historic village, where guests can step back in time and walk over the oldest Bridge in Australia and explore this quaint historic town.

Huon Valley Safaris

The Huon Valley, south of Hobart, is a foodie's paradise with scenery to match. On the Huon Valley Safaris tour, guests will taste the best of the south as well as visit the D'Entrecasteaux Channel for a cheese tasting at one of the most sustainable cheeseries in Australia. Tours depart Hobart at approx. 8.30 am and return at 4 pm.

After collection, the tour starts with a drive to the summit of kunanyi/Mt Wellington (weather dependent), where guests can experience the best view of Hobart & surrounds, on a clear day, it is possible to see as far as Maria Island on Tasmania's east coast! The journey continues south to Willie Smith Cider Shed in Huonville for an organic cider tasting and a slice of their famous apple pie.

The Kiln Eatery is one of our next stops. The property dates back to the 1800s when almost ten million apples were packed yearly from the 52-hectare apple orchards. The Kiln is home to De Quetteville Distillery, where guests will be offered tastings of their garden gin infused with local botanicals.

The tour stops by Pagan Cider for another tasty cider tasting & lunch before continuing to Cygnet, a quirky town known for its artists and annual folk festival. The last stop of the day is the award-winning Grandvewe Cheese & Hartshorn Distillery. With a focus on sustainability and working with other local businesses, Grandvewe is the only cheesery in Tasmania to focus solely on sheep's cheese. Hartshorn Distillery creates smooth vodka and gin from sheep whey, winning World's Best Vodka in 2018. Guests are treated to a cheese and spirits tasting while a Grandvewe staff member shares the Grandvewe story and their sustainability efforts.

On the way back to Hobart, guests will be treated to the stunning views of the D'Entrecasteaux Channel, looking over to Bruny Island. This tour aims to showcase the diverse local produce and people of the Huon Valley, one of Tasmania's less well-known tourist regions.
