Easily visited on day trips by road or air or for the full experience, choose to immerse yourself in this stunning and remote location by staying a night or two on the farm in a genuine pearling shack, glamping safari tent or campgrounds. Explore the iconic destinations of the Dampier Peninsula, the Buccaneer Archipelago, and Horizontal Falls, all from Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm. The home of the Australian pearl, Cygnet Bay offers you the rare opportunity to purchase pearls direct from the waters in which they were farmed. Dine in style, overlooking the bay, relax by our infinity pool, view natural phenomena such as the staircase to the moon and Waterfall Reef, and discover the world's largest tropical tides at Broome's working pearl farm – an absolute must for any trip to Broome and surrounds.

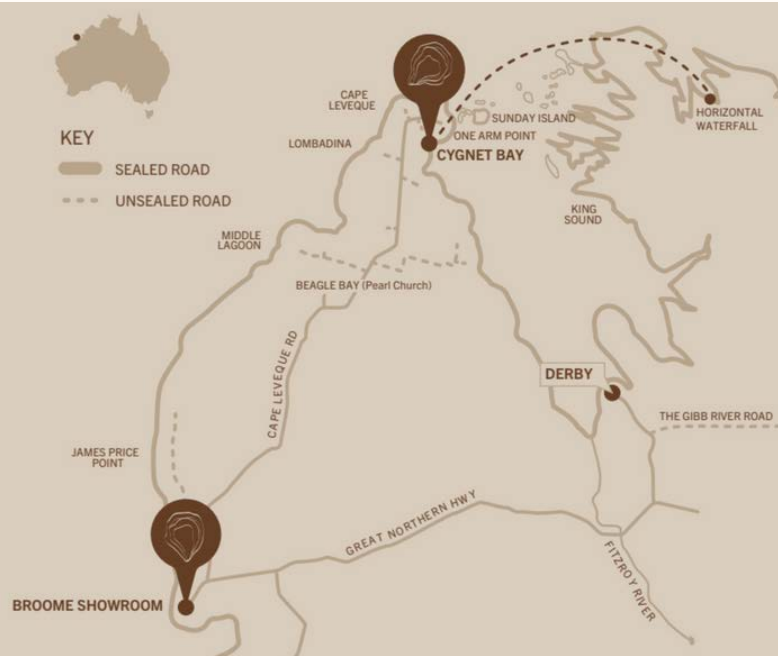

Explore the Kimberley coast, a pristine wilderness renowned for its ancient geological formations and home to the world’s largest tropical tides. Cygnet Bay serves as your gateway to the Buccaneer Archipelago's thousands of islands. Our amphibious vessels offer a unique vantage point to spot diverse wildlife like turtles, dolphins, seabirds, and whales. Embark on a journey filled with awe-inspiring landscapes and unforgettable encounters with nature in this remote and untouched corner of the world.

Our marine experiences are tidal dependent. **Spring tides** are larger tidal movements that occur around the full and new moon. This is when currents are strongest and it is the best time to see whirlpools, standing waves and Waterfall Reef. In between spring tides are smaller **neap tides**. The slower currents are the perfect time to cruise the islands of the Buccaneer Archipelago and for our pearling team to dive for wild shell.

Our marine tours require a moderate mobility level as guests may be required to perform an on-water transfer between vessels with assistance from crew. Seating styles vary between vessels and include bench and straddle seating.

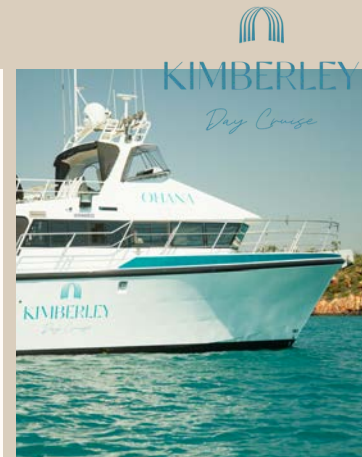

Due to our remote location, there is limited Telstra service and no WiFi available in our accommodation. Guest WiFi is available at the restaurant. Cygnet Bay is located on a pristine coastline with ancient mangroves and remnant rainforests. We are fortunate to share this country with much wildlife in their natural habitat. Our team work to ensure that guests have an unforgettable experience and that both wildlife and guests are protected.

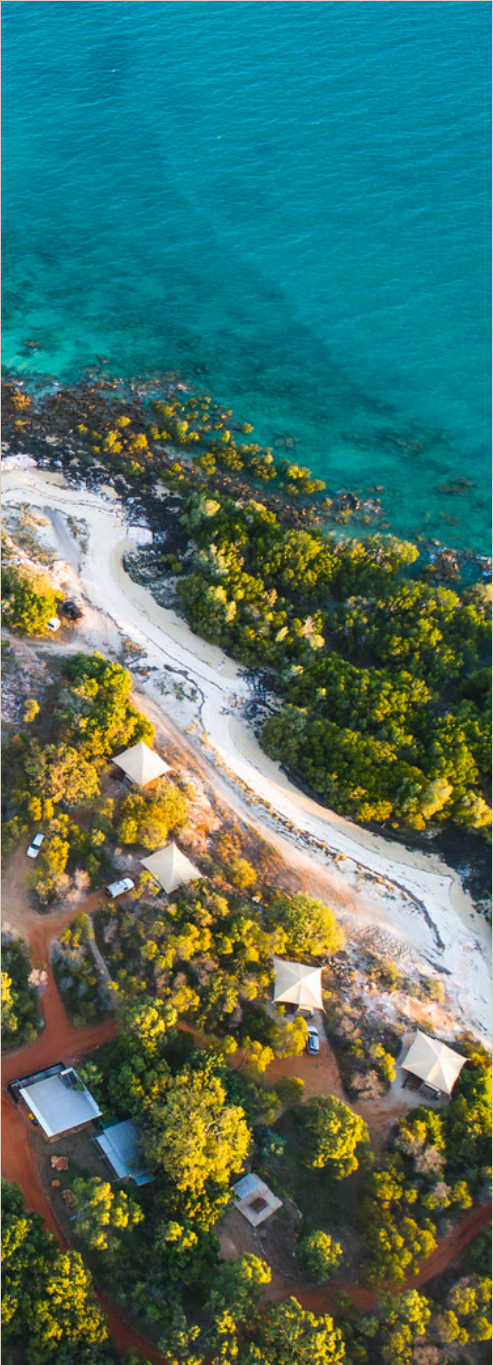

Our Diver's Creek accommodation is situated one kilometre from the main pearling village, reception and restaurant and **requires a 4WD**. Mangroves turn into tidal creeks and rocky points offering fresh oysters and great spots for fishing, small sandy beaches are the perfect beach-combing location and our bush tracks offer great bird watching and secluded hideaways. All tents have private ensuites and share a camp kitchen and BBQ area. Nestled between the foreshore and remnant Kimberley rainforest, tents are situated to maximise the feeling of privacy.

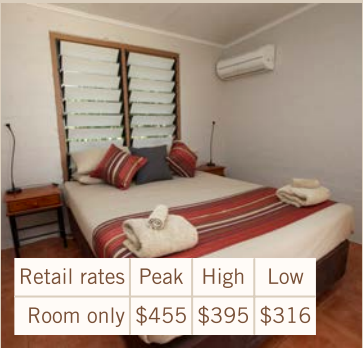

PEARLER’S SHACKS

The little tidal creek commonly known as Diver’s Creek (Nuboloon in Bardi) was the perfect natural harbour for our old wooden Luggers. It provided protection from cyclones, a convenient place to unload the valuable pearl shell and re-provision for the next adventure out to the pearling beds. The old stack sack jetty can still be seen in the creek. Today, the area and the old buildings are heritage listed for the significant part it all played in pioneering the Australian cultured pearling industry. Situated one kilometre from the main Pearling Village at Diver’s Creek.

DRIVE: (2 hours north of Broome) on the Cape Leveque Road. The road is fully sealed, however, 4WDs are still required to reach many locations on the peninsula. The 3km driveway at Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm is unsealed but has been graded for 2WD access.

WHAT TO BRING

Hat, sunscreen, insect repellent, water bottle, wind protection for boat, camera, bathers, towel and a sense of adventure! Flat enclosed shoes are recommended.

WHAT'S THE TIDE?

Did you know that the Kimberley has the largest tropical tides in the world? On a king tide, water depth can vary up to 10m between high and low tide at Cygnet Bay. On Bardi Jawi Country, we live by the seasons and the moon. We don't check the time, we check the tide.

Spring tides are larger tidal movements that occur around the full and new moon. This is when currents are strongest and it is the best time to see whirlpools, standing waves and Waterfall Reef. In between spring tides are smaller neap tides. The slower currents are the perfect time to cruise the islands of the Buccaneer Archipelago and for our pearling team to dive for wild shell.

ENVIRONMENT & WILDLIFE

Broome and Cygnet Bay is in a tropical climate zone. Seasons are typically described as the wet season (October to April) or the dry season (April to October), although Bardi and other First Nations typically recognise six seasons. The wet season is categorised by hot days and nights, high humidity, lightning storms and flash flooding. During the wet season, Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm has a reduced tours and accommodation offering. The dry season brings pleasant warm days and cool nights and is the typical tourist season.

Cygnet Bay is located on a pristine coastline with ancient mangroves and remnant rainforests. We are fortunate to share this country with much wildlife in their natural habitat. Be aware that wildlife includes birds, frogs, lizards, snakes, bats, mosquitoes, sandflies, spiders, insects, crabs, oysters, fish, octopus, stingrays, turtles, whales, dolphins, crocodiles, sharks, dugongs, and many others. Our team work to ensure that guests have an unforgettable experience and are safe from dangerous wildlife encounters.



STAIRCASE TO THE MOON

Witness the monthly natural phenomenon of Staircase to the Moon from Cygnet Bay Pearl Farm as the full moon rises casting moonlight on the intertidal zone of the front beach. Purchase a cold beverage from the restaurant bar and take the short walk to the lookout for the best vantage point. Check our events calendar on our website to see dates and moonrise times.

WHILST STAYING WITH US WE RECOMMEND

- Want to go fishing? We recommend high tide on the old jetty at Divers Creek, off the rocks at White Rocks Point at low tide or hiring our dinghy to fish in the bay.
- Low tide is perfect for oystering off White Rocks Point or exploring the mangroves, tidal flats, and rockpools at the front beach. Be careful as the rocks can be slippery and sharp with oyster shells.
- Incoming tide is when the mud crabs come out to feast in the inter-tidal zone - they taste so good it's worth the effort!
- Search for our corals on a king low tide out the front beach or beach-combing along the sand and mud flats.
- Bird watching is great - borrow a bird guide from reception to identify what you see.
