Taste your way through Australia's history on this expert-led Sydney walking tour, where each bite helps tell the story of a nation's evolving food culture.

Perfect for those who have just arrived, as well as locals and those who want to go deeper in learning about Australian food, history, culture and more.

Starting from Customs House, your guide will give you a brief introduction to Sydney's history and the significance of where the tour starts. You'll then head off for a coffee and learn about Australia's casual, healthy and deeply-embedded cafe culture – and how this has now been exported around the world.

Afterwards, you'll venture into Sydney's city centre, making your way towards the Queen Victoria Building before looping back towards Circular Quay, with a range of mouth-watering food stops along the way. To save time, we might take the light rail back to Circular Quay (at your own expense).

You'll finish at an Aboriginal-led restaurant under the sails of the Sydney Opera House with harbour views of the Bridge, with a shared grazing platter of native Australian foods.

PRIVATE TOUR & GROUP TOUR BOOKINGS PAYMENT POLICY

A deposit of 10% of the quoted tour minimum may be requested to hold the tour date.

Full payment is required 7 days before departure.

Bookings are not confirmed until a booking confirmation number is received, or an invoice is written and sent by the Operator.

If the Operator is forced to cancel a booked tour, any prior payments will be fully refunded.

The Operator runs tours in all weather, though reserves the right to alter or amend an itinerary if circumstances require.

GROUP CANCELLATION NOTIFICATIONS

- For private tours, cancellations made 7 days or more before the activity starts will receive a full refund; cancellations made between 3 and 7 days before the activity starts will receive a 50% refund, and 100% cancellation fee will apply for any cancellations made within 3 days (72 hours) of the activity.

- For any reduction of group size within 3 days (72 hours) of the activity, a 100% cancellation fee will apply. These amendments must be provided in writing within a minimum of 24 hours prior to the activity.
- You can reschedule the date or time of your experience up to 3 days (72 hours) prior to the activity without penalty. However, should the rescheduled departure be cancelled, the original dates' cancellation policy will apply. A 100% cancellation fee will apply.
- All cancellation/change requests must be received by email, and any amendments to be approved and confirmed by Local Sauce Tours.

FOC/Famil POLICY

All FOC tours and FAMILs must be approved in advance and requested in writing.

FIT BOOKING CONDITIONS

Minimum Number of Participants

No minimum for any scheduled public departure.
