Fact File: The Mackerel Islands offer self-catered accommodation, activities and tours for an adventurous, off the beaten track experience in the coastal outback of Western Australia. Easy to get to, the islands are located north of Exmouth, a short 22km hop off the mainland of Onslow, on the mid-coast of WA in the spectacular Pilbara region. Access is via a 35 minute scenic flight from Exmouth/Learmonth with Ningaloo Aviation, or for guests travelling with their own boat, a 45 minute boat trip from Onslow. Home to fringing reefs, sandy beaches, secluded bays, gorgeous sunsets and wildlife encounters, the Mackerel Islands are visited by sea turtles, dolphins, dugongs, whales and stingrays. Wake up to warm, sunny days and the sound of the ocean from the spacious, air-conditioned beachfront cabins. Snorkel with turtles and colourful tropical fish, go kayaking, bird watching and beach fishing.

Beachfront Cabins: Feature a fully-equipped kitchen, lounge, indoor and outdoor dining areas, king or twin beds, private bathroom with additional second toilet, air-conditioning, flat screen TV, hammock and a Weber BBQ. All cabins are powered by solar and have hot freshwater.

Located a 1,400km drive north of Perth (between Exmouth and Karratha) for self-drive/road trip enthusiasts, or a 2-hour flight with Virgin Australia or Qantas operating Perth (PER) to Onslow Airport (ONS).

Originally known as Ashburton, Onslow is a beachfront town with a history steeped in sheep and cattle farming, pearl farming and gold mining. It is the oldest town in the Ashburton Shire and one of the gateways to the Mackerel Islands which are located a short 22km hop off the mainland. Travel between Onslow and the Karijini National Park takes about 5-6 hours on a sealed road.

The epic Pilbara region, twice the size of the United Kingdom, has some of the world's most stunning ancient natural landscapes, dating back 3.5 – 4.3 billion years. From coastal to inland, sapphire seas and offshore islands, to the pulsing red heart of the outback, travel to remote beaches, deep gorges, plunging waterfalls, soaring ranges, and experience the ancient Aboriginal culture of the Pilbara. A land of contrasts and juxtapositions – ancient indigenous sites and colonial settlements; pristine untouched landscapes and a powerhouse mining industry; colours of the red earth, white salt lakes and blue ocean. This is where you'll discover the real Aussie outback.

Fact File: Unique outback glamping in the heart of the spectacular Karijini National Park. 100% Aboriginal-owned by Gumala Enterprises, proudly representing the Banjima, Yinhawangka and Nyiyaparli people of the Pilbara region. One of Australia's leading eco-tourism attractions, Karijini Eco Retreat offers eco tents, cabins and campsites nestled at the edge of Joffre Gorge, along with an outback style restaurant and bar, and access to the park's walks, hikes, gorges, waterfalls, wild swimming spots and guided adventure tours. Situated 1,500km north of Perth, Karijini Eco Retreat can be reached from the Paraburdoo and Newman Airports with car hire available at the airports, or self-drive on a coastal route via Exmouth, Onslow, Karratha or Port Hedland, or an inland route via the towns of Cue and Meekatharra.

Karijini is the second largest national park in WA, covering 627,422 hectares, and one of the state's top attractions. A timeless place full of ancient energy, the breathtaking labyrinth of plunging chasms was formed more than two billion years ago and is home to a variety of colourful wildflowers and native wildlife. Visitors can immerse themselves in nature exploring a wonderland of deep gorges, slot canyons, red cliffs, towering waterfalls, turquoise waterholes and sparkling rock pools, surrounded by beautiful bushland. A 4WD vehicle is recommended as there is a mix of sealed and unsealed roads.

Deluxe Eco Tents: Feature hotel quality bedding, linen, towels. Partially enclosed ensuite bathroom with solar hot water shower, flushing toilet, basin. Zipped canvas entry and front deck with table and chairs. Solar powered lights, minimal power for low wattage applications (charging camera battery, mobile phone).
