Nitmiluk Gorge features some of the most stunning gorge scenery in the Northern Territory, with raging waterfalls (in the wet season), a myriad of wildlife and simply breathtaking views of the Jawoyn country.

The Gorge system winds along 12km of sheer rock, some more than 70m high. Consisting of 13 separate gorges, Nitmiluk Gorge is a maze of waterways sculpted from the sandstone over countless millennia by the Katherine River. Nitmiluk Tours is the specialist agent, with a great variety of tours that allow guests to immerse themselves in the history, rugged beauty and culture of this majestic region.

Nitmiluk Gorge is located 30 km from the Township of Katherine, along Giles St/ Gorge Road on a sealed road.

What to bring:

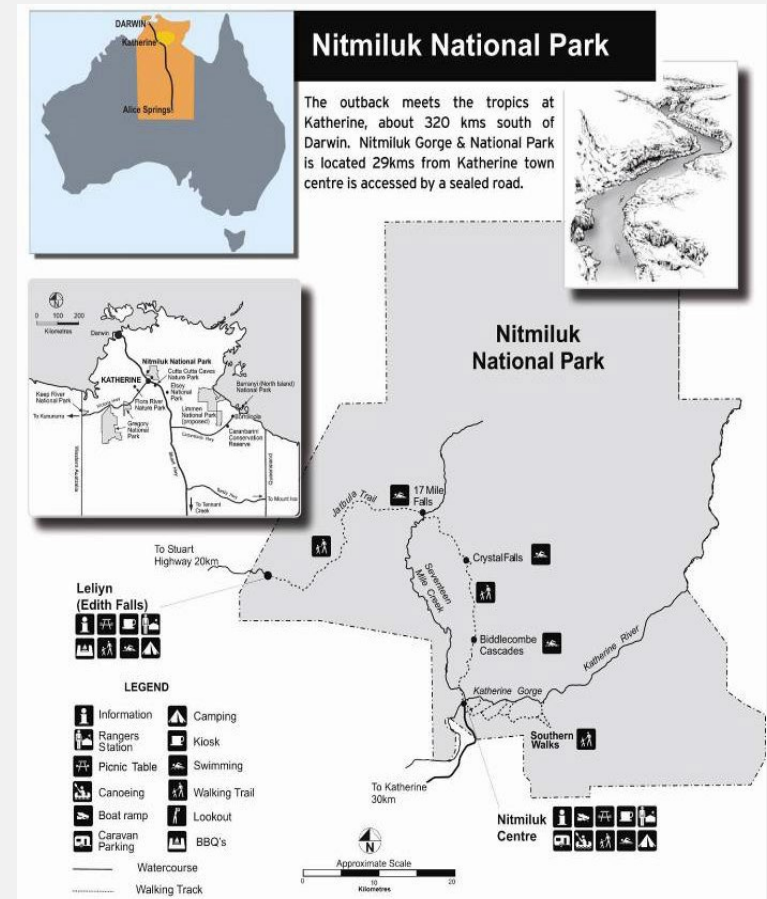
All guests are encouraged to carry bottled water, wear closed in (non-slip) shoes, wear a hat and sunscreen whilst exploring Nitmiluk National Park.

Boat Tours

Nitmiluk Gorge is made up of 13 separate Gorges, sculpted from the sandstone over countless millennia by the Katherine River. You are invited to experience the beauty, history, and culture of Nitmiluk National Park.

During the tour, our knowledgeable guides will share stories and information on the landscape, history, and culture of Nitmiluk as you travel up the first 2 – 3 Gorges.

Each gorge is separated by natural rock barriers, therefore walking between the gorges is required on all tours to change boats. Walkways are man-made, however can be uneven in areas as they follow the natural contours of the bush landscape. The pathways include steps with handrails. A moderate level of mobility is required.

Canoe Adventure Tours

Nitmiluk Gorge is one of the most picturesque places to canoe in Australia – a canoe trip is a great way to escape the crowds and experience the splendour of the gorge yourself. Canoeing in this environment can be as challenging as you choose, but always rewarding for those who want to get in touch with nature. All canoe tours are self-guided, allowing you freedom to explore at your own pace. Canoe tours are inclusive of life jackets and paddles (double ended).

Canoe tours commence with a scenic boat ride through the first gorge, before canoeists take to the water on a self-guided adventure through the second gorge and beyond.

Helicopter Touring

All flights depart from the Nitmiluk helipad, located a three-minute drive from the Nitmiluk Visitor Centre. There are a variety of flights to choose from, all offer magnificent views from the air and include photo or video opportunities of Nitmiluk Gorge, the Arnhem Land escarpment and local wildlife.

Boat Transfers

Nitmiluk National Park is home to many waterfalls, most of which are seasonal and rely on the annual rains to bring them into full flow. December - March are typically the wettest months in the Top End.

The Southern Rockhole is a seasonal waterfall, located towards the top of the first gorge. This Rockhole is 4km (each way) by foot, or alternatively you can catch a ferry! Ferries are available either one-way (with the option of walking one way) or return. The ferry will take you within 150m of the Rockhole, you are then required to walk the remainder of the way. The walk is not a manmade path, and is rock-hopping most of the way in. As such, a moderate level of fitness and mobility is required. Swimming is only permitted when the Rockhole has been opened by NT Parks and Wildlife.

The Jatbula Trail is an iconic walk venturing from Nitmiluk Gorge to Edith Falls, following the traditional song lines of the Jawoyn Ancestors. Once a booking has been secured for this 5-day trek, guests are required cross the river to commence the walk. The short boat ride will start your memorable journey through Jawoyn Country.

Cultural Experiences

The Jawoyn people are the traditional owners of the area known as Nitmiluk National Park. For thousands of years, they have maintained their culture and traditions through the stories passed from one generation to another. Learn and discover this ancient culture through one of our Cultural Experiences.

Ancient Garlarr River Safari: Designed for guests wanting a more intimate experience of Jawoyn Country, this 2.5hr river tour is guided by one of our knowledgeable cultural guides through the first gorge. Guests will learn about Jawoyn traditions, and how many are still practiced today.

Footsteps of our Ancestors – 2hr Presentation: This two-hour cultural presentation will provide an insight to the Jawoyn Culture. Our Indigenous guides will provide information on traditional activities such as basket weaving, spear throwing, fire lighting, painting, and didgeridoo playing.

Footsteps of our Ancestors – Hands-on Experience: Be welcomed by members of the local Indigenous community for a hands-on cultural experience. You will spend the day with the Jawoyn people, sharing their culture, learning their ways and trying some of the skills developed over thousands of years. Activities include basket weaving, spear throwing, fire lighting, painting, and learning the didgeridoo. A traditional meal of kangaroo tail and barbequed meat served with a selection of fresh salads will be served for lunch.

Cutta Cutta Caves

Cutta Cutta Caves Nature Park is located 28 km south of Katherine and is easily accessible from the Stuart Highway. The park covers 1499 hectares of limestone landscape, and is home to five species of bats, including the rare Ghost and Horseshoe bats. About 170 species of birds have been recorded within the park, including the Hooded Parrot and the endangered Gouldian Finch.

Guided tours are offered to allow guests to explore the tropical limestone cave system.

Walking approximately 1500m is required to carry out a tour. This is made up of natural, uneven paths, stairs (with handrails), and man-made walkways.

Closed shoes must be worn to enter the cave.
