(Certified Junior Open Water Divers from 10 years old) Guests will be required to complete an online waiver & provide a copy of their certification. If divers have not dived for several years we will insist on clients having a refresher session, or dive as a intro diver for the first dive both attract additional costs or utilise our private guide option for the first day. Introductory Diving Policy / Notes	Introductory scuba diving is available for first timers. Please note the minimum age to participate is 12 years old. No prior experience needed. Certified instructors provide full safety and equipment briefings, then guide you underwater for about 20 minutes to a maximum depth of 10 metres. Health restrictions apply - Guests will be required to complete the PADI Diver Medical Questionnaire. If you answer "Yes" to any item (e.g., asthma, heart/cardiac issues, diabetes, ear/sinus problems, recent surgery, pregnancy), doctor's clearance may be required before diving.
Child Policy	Children minimum age to participate is 7+. Children are charged at the adult rate. Introductory Diving minimum age is 12 years old. Certified Junior Open Water Divers from 10 years old.
