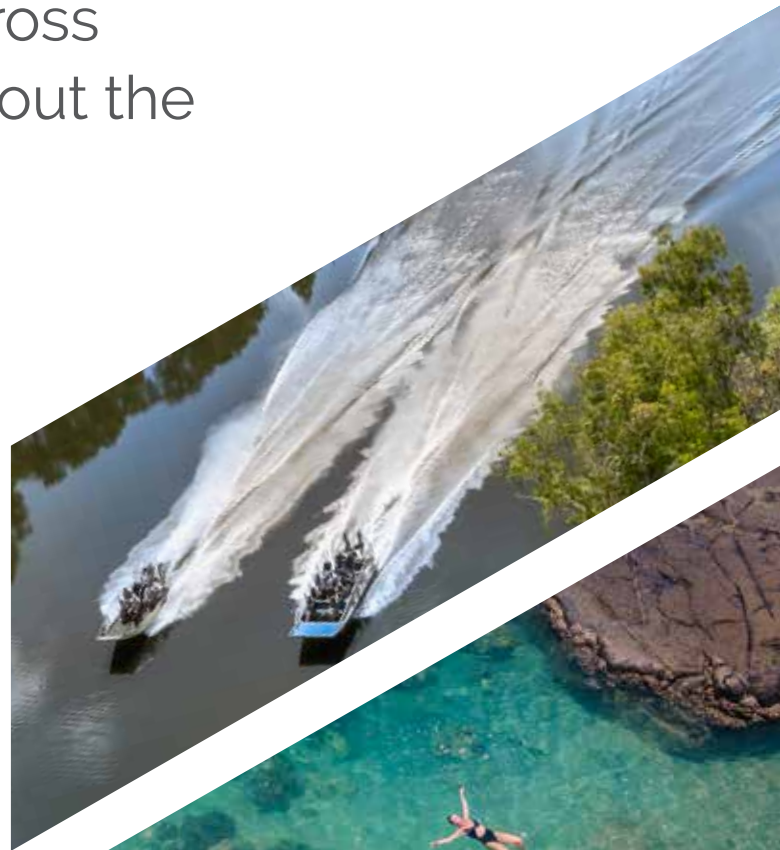
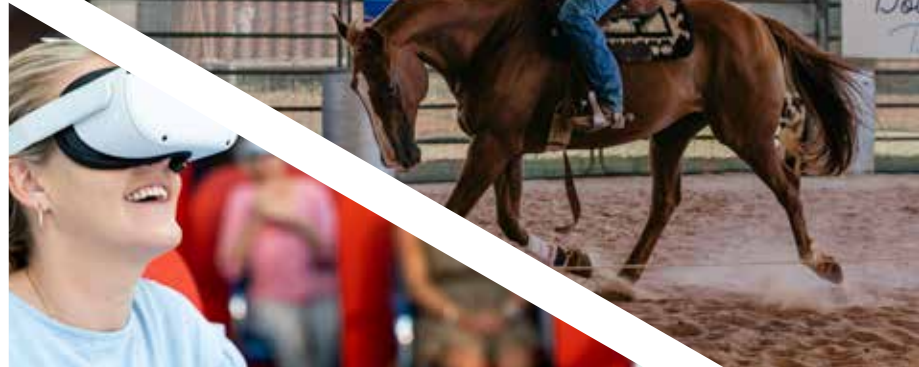

COWS & CANAPÉS

End your day with this uniquely Territory experience. Sip sundowners from an open buggy as curious Brahman cattle wander nearby. Jump out for a selfie, soak in the golden hour, and hear personal stories from local guides who share the station's rich family history—all while surrounded by the stunning outback scenery of Finniss River Station.

Bird lovers will be in their element. The floodplains support thousands of waterbirds, including over 1% of the world's populations of Magpie Geese and Pied Herons. With three major breeding colonies on-site and sightings of five threatened species, Finniss River is a rare and rewarding destination for twitchers and casual birders alike.

Tread a path amongst the five ecosystems with abundant opportunities to photograph and observe wildlife in their natural habitat. Walking trails are tailored to suit all abilities. The Lodge offers a number of short, leisurely walks and for the more adventurous, half or full day treks.

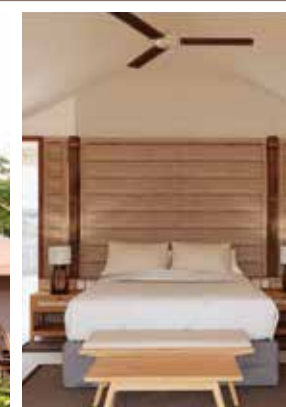

The Top End of the Northern Territory is known for its tropical weather, crocodiles, rich indigenous culture, great fishing, national parks and laid-back lifestyle.

Wherever you travel in the Top End, you'll pass through country traditionally associated with different Aboriginal language groups. Aboriginal people are proud of their land and welcome visitors who come to learn about their country and culture.

The Northern Territory is vast. Occupying about one sixth of Australia's total land mass, its boundaries encompass a variety of contrasting landscapes and experiences, best tackled by exploring a few key destinations – each with their own distinct personality.

It is home to an eclectic mix of cultures whose outdoor lifestyle is complemented by brilliant sunsets, fantastic fishing and a colourful calendar of outdoor events.

Darwin is the Northern Territory's multicultural capital, famed for its markets and festivals, Asian cuisine and beautiful natural harbour. It is also the perfect base from which to explore the natural treasures of World Heritage-listed Kakadu and Litchfield National Parks as well as the Tiwi Islands.

Kakadu National Park, the largest national park in Australia, is situated 254 kilometres from Darwin on the Arnhem Highway. Renowned internationally for its natural and cultural wonders, Kakadu has one of the highest concentrated areas of Aboriginal rock art sites in the world.

Further south, the Katherine region is a vast network of rivers, escarpments and gorges that weave through sprawling plains of cattle stations, national parks and reserves. In Nitmiluk National Park, the mighty Katherine River slices through towering sandstone cliffs to form the world famous Nitmiluk (Katherine) Gorge.

Aboriginal people are the original custodians of the Top End and have a unique relationship with the land. Their art and Dreamtime stories weave a connection between spirit and country and provide modern travellers with a deeper understanding and insight to the mysteries of land and waters.

Darwin

Darwin is a lively harbour city well-known as Australia's gateway to world-class nature and cultural activities and experiences. With a population in excess of 130,000, it is a destination renowned for its tropical climate and colourful characters. Situated on the edge of a harbour bigger than Sydney's, Darwin is a beautiful, fascinating tropical city – a melting pot of people and cultures that prides itself in its unique and friendly laid-back lifestyle. While a sophisticated, modern city in its own right, it is also one steeped in history, one that has endured many hardships including being bombed more times than Pearl Harbour as part of the airraids of February 1942 and Cyclone Tracy in 1974. You can learn more about these events at various attractons in and around Darwin. The centre of NT commerce and business and with its world-class natural and cultural attractions it is also a thriving hub of activity in terms of tourism, nightlife and retail and a vibrant market scene. The gateway to Asia, the city is accessible from Singapore, Bali and Kuala Lumpa.

Litchfield National Park

Feel yourself unwind as you float in lush waterholes with misty waterfalls nestled among dramatic landscapes. Only a 60-minute drive south of Darwin, Litchfield National Park is possibly the Northern Territory's best kept secret. Litchfield National Park features a myriad of diverse environments including rugged sandstone escarpments, perennial spring-fed streams, monsoon rainforest, magnetic termite mounds, waterfalls and historic ruins. The park is filled with stunning waterfalls and waterholes that are surrounded by monsoonal vine forests – all of which offer a cool respite on warm summer days. A drive through Litchfield is full of contrasts and some of the most enormous termite mounds in the Top End

Nhulunbuy & East Arnhem Land

Discover the remote magic of Nhulunbuy and East Arnhem Land, where rugged coastlines meet rich Aboriginal culture. Located on the Gove Peninsula, this untouched region is home to the Yolngu people, who welcome visitors through immersive cultural tours and experiences. Think endless white beaches, world-class fishing, and art that tells stories thousands of years old. Bremer Island is the perfect day tour or overnight destination. A true, remote island paradise. From the red dirt roads to the turquoise seas, this is a destination for true explorers. Whether you're camping under the stars or relaxing at an eco retreat. East Arnhem Land promises an unforgettable escape into one of Australia's most extraordinary regions.

Kakadu National Park

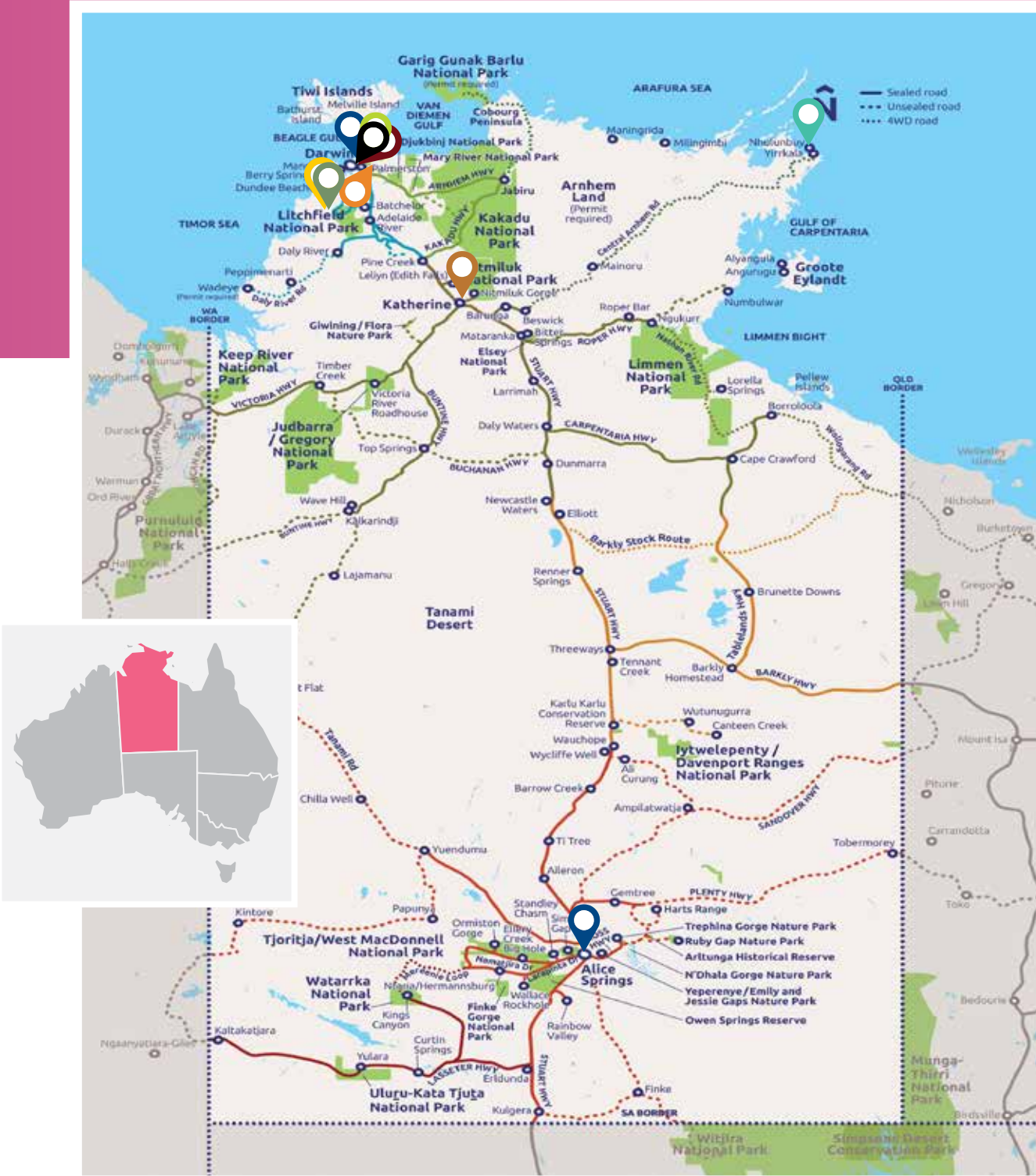
World Heritage-listed Kakadu National Park, covering almost 20,000 square kilometres, is a place of contrasting landscapes and diverse habitats. Saltwater crocodiles lurk in freshwater billabongs dotted with lotus lilies. Rugged cliffs of the Arnhem Land escarpment hide deep sandstone gorges and pockets of monsoon rainforest. Waterfalls cascade into pools fringed with paperbarks and pandanus.

World Heritage-listed Kakadu National Park, covering more than 19,000 square kilometres, is a landscape of contrasts. Beneath waters dotted with lotus flowers, saltwater crocodiles lurk. Parts of the monsoon rainforest are hidden behind the jagged peaks of towering escarpments, pools are bordered by paperbarks, pandanus and cycads. A visit to the awe-inspiring Jim Jim Falls, browsing through a gallery of ancient Aboriginal rock art at Ubirr or Nourlangie Rock, or exploring the scenic Yellow Water, a billabong teeming with wildlife is a must when at Kakadu National Park. More than a third of Australian bird species, around 1000 plant species and 25% of freshwater fish species in Australia are found in Kakadu National Park.

Katherine

Kick off your Katherine adventure in the NT's third-largest town. Try a spot of caving, join a river cruise, or fly over the stunning Katherine Gorge. The Northern territory's third-largest town, Katherine is on the banks of the Katherine River, which flows from the nearby world-renowned Katherine Gorge (Nitmiluk National Park). Cruise, canoe, bushwalk or fly over magnificent Katherine Gorge in Nitmiluk National Park, soak in Mataranka's thermal pool and visit the setting of the famous novel We of the Never Never in Elsey National Park. Land a barramundi in the Daly River region, touch the explorer's 1856 inscription carved on a boab tree in Gregory National Park or survey the Gulf region's 'Lost City' from the air. While its star attraction is undoubtedly the famous Nitmiluk (Katherine Gorge), Katherine and its surrounds include great fishing, hidden natural wonders and a rich Aboriginal and pioneering history.
