MUSEUM OF OLD AND NEW ART

Mona is the playground and megaphone of Mona creator David Walsh. Located just up the river from Hobart's waterfront, Mona's three-level subterranean architecture showcases the highlights (and lowlights) of David Walsh's private collection of art and antiquities - the largest private art collection in the southern hemisphere.

As well as hosting a busy exhibitions program, Mona is also home to Moorilla Winery, Faro Bar + Restaurant, The Source Restaurant, bars, eateries, luxury accommodation, a recording studio, live music and much, much more.

They also own a brewery (Moo Brew) but it's not on site.

1. MONA LIKE A ROCKSTAR

Ferry. Feast. Fancy art. Flashy views. Fine wine. A full-frontal Mona experience.

Treat yourself to a posh-as guided day out at Mona, designed for guests who want it all.

ITINERARY:

10.15am

Journey to Mona in the Posh Pit—the ferry's lavish private lounge, bar and deck—devour complimentary canapés and beverages on the thirty minute voyage along the River Derwent.

10.45am

Free time to explore Mona and the grounds, including live music on the Lawns.
